Monitoring Requirements Not Met For Newport Borough Water Authority

Our water system violated drinking water regulations over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these violations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the time period Of spring, 2011, we did not test for the contaminants listed in the table below, and therefore, cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What Should You Do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminants we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for this/these contaminants and how many samples we are supposed to take; how many samples we took; when samples should have been taken; and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.
